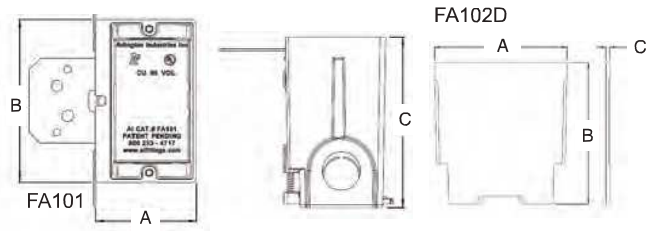

Installation Instructions



1 Attach IN/OUT BOX to wood or steel stud with captive installation screws. Feed the wires through the knockout.



2 If the box is too far forward or back, simply adjust the depth by turning the screw.
