A potential safety issue has been identified with Appleton SPLS Pilot Lights whereby the Guard when pulled separates from the sleeve. This condition could cause equipment damage and /or serious personal injury.

We have determined this condition could exist in a small percentage of products which utilize the SPLS pilot light with manufacture date codes from November 2010 through February 2011.

Our records indicate that you purchased one or more products that include this SPLS pilot light during this timeframe (see the attached for quantities, shipment dates, and purchase order numbers). You're being requested to evaluate all potentially affected products that may be in your inventory according to the attached illustration.



For products with Pilot Light Assembled as shown, Firmly grasp the black Guard and pull away from the unit.


Black Guard shouldn't come out loose
